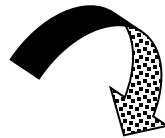

SAFEKEEPING OF YOUR WILL & OTHER IMPORTANT DOCUMENTS

Wills kept at home are at risk of being lost or destroyed by fire. Caution should be exercised when keeping your will in a safety deposit box as well. Sometimes people move away without leaving a forwarding address with the institution, leaving their Will behind in a box. Your executor may not be able to locate your Will at the very time it is needed. Some alternative storage options are as follows:

- Your lawyer's office
- Your Conference office vault
- File it with the Clerk in the Surrogate Court in the area where you live

Whatever you decide, it's a good idea to let your executor know where your Will is kept. This will facilitate an easier administration of your estate for your executor.

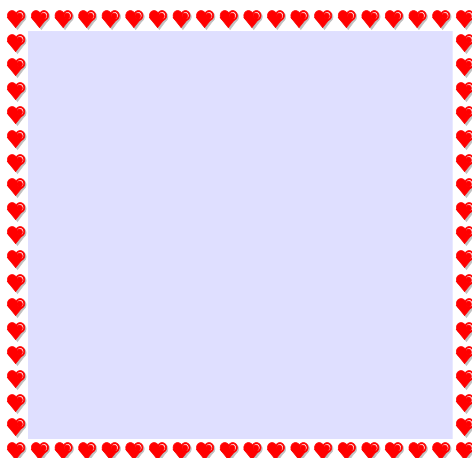
