You can write proposals that win friends as well as funding

The Steps:

- 1. Keep your ear to the ground.** In addition to spiritual needs, is your community feeling and expressing other needs that you might help with?
- 2. Think, Talk, Pray.** Think and talk with your friends and other church members about how your congregation might help meet a need that the community has expressed. Pray for guidance and God's leading.
- 3. Write a draft proposal and contact the Director of Planned Giving/Philanthropy.**
In your proposal, write one sentence that clearly identifies the need, and another that explains what you will do to help. Make a short list of key words that describe who you will help. The Director can then run a search and forward the results to you.

- 4. Research the sources and target your proposal.**
Once you've dug down further into the search results, choose one potential funder. Tailor your proposal to that organization, and send the proposal to the Director. Together, you'll decide on a submission strategy.

The Policy:

All grant proposals and contact with foundations must be co-ordinated through the Alberta Conference Director of Planned Giving/Philanthropy.
